


The Georgia Public Library Service (GPLS) presents the 2016 edition of "A Current Look at Georgia's Public Libraries and GPLS", offering a detailed examination of the statistical data that describes the operations, funding and usage of the 409 public library facilities throughout our state. This report highlights the value of each of these libraries and the services and programs they offer in every county in Georgia through the 63 Georgia public library systems.

This report offers statistical data and analysis of Fiscal Year 2016, which began July 1, 2015 and ended June 30, 2016. Each of the 63 public library system submits an annual report to GPLS; these annual reports provide the data utilized in the preparation of "A Current Look." Our aggregate data will be submitted, as required, to the federal Institute for Museum and Library Services (IMLS) in spring 2017 for inclusion in the national Public Library Survey, which provides a national view of public library facilities, services, and funding. Therefore, this data is still subject to IMLS review in 2017.

"A Current Look" provides timely, detailed analysis in ways that we hope are useful to those who fund, support and use public libraries in Georgia. This year's report shows increases statewide in circulation per capita, particularly in E-books; statewide, holdings of E-books have increased over 75% in the last year as Georgia libraries respond to increasing requests for this format. The demand for electronic services continues to grow, and Georgia libraries are responding by adding computers and digital resources. Georgia libraries are essential to every community, and we see this in the nearly 28 million visits to libraries during the year as well as an almost 5% increase in attendance at library programs. Despite ranking #47 in total per capita funding nationally, Georgia's libraries were able to increase overall public service hours in the state for the second year in a row, and continue to offer an impressive array of programs and services that support economic and workforce development, innovation, discovery, entrepreneurship, and education at all levels.

To the community leaders, trustees, administrators and funders at the state and local level, whose support make the services we deliver to every community possible, we appreciate you. We are all partners in making Georgia's public libraries successful. Georgia's libraries are committed to our role in creating a more educated Georgia.

Georgia's Library Laws

- By statutory authority, Georgia Public Library Service, as a unit of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, gives aid, counsel and advice to all libraries in Georgia and works in a limited supervisory capacity with the 63 public library systems
- **OCGA § 20-5-2 (a)** states that the agency “... shall give aid, advice and counsel to all libraries” and “shall exercise supervision over all public libraries and endeavor to improve libraries already established.”
- **OCGA § 20-2-305 (a)** states that the agency “... shall annually determine and request of the General Assembly the amount of funds needed for county and regional public libraries” and that “Public Library funds shall be apportioned to county and regional public libraries in proportion to the area and population to be served by such libraries . . .”
- Public library systems in Georgia are either single-county or multiple-county, based on the individual participating agreements. There are currently 34 multiple-county (regional) public library systems and 29 single-county public library systems. **OCGA § 20-5-41** places authority of single-county library systems with the county board of trustees and places authority of multiple-county library systems with the regional board of trustees.
- While GPLS strongly supports efficiency and economy in the operation of public library systems, it realizes that local preferences, history and political realities drive the decisions of how public libraries are configured and aligned. It is the role of GPLS to advocate for strong, fiscally sound and viable public libraries.

The Value of Public Library Services

- If a **family of four** together borrows two books and two DVDs each month, attends one program per quarter and annually takes advantage of the museum and attraction passes available at every public library in the state, that family would **save more than \$1,670 every year** over the cost of buying those materials and tickets individually. *In addition, there is the value of public-access Internet, job skills training, homework help, and dozens of other services that Georgia libraries routinely provide free of charge!*
- **2 books per month per year**
 - The average book costs \$25.00.
 - This saved the family of four a total of **\$600**.
- **2 DVDs per month all year**
 - The average price of a new DVD is \$29.99
 - This saved the family of four a total of **\$720**.
- **1 library program per quarter**
 - The average cost of a movie ticket was \$8.65.
 - This saved the family of four a total of **\$138**.
- **1 time per year using the museum and attraction passes at Zoo Atlanta, Go Fish, the Carlos Museum, the Center for Puppetry Arts, the Atlanta Hawks, the Atlanta Braves, and the State Park Pass**
 - This saved the family of four a total of **\$240**.


The value of public library services is almost **\$1700 for just these services!**

State Funding for Georgia's Public Libraries

- By state law OCGA § 20-5-3, state funding is apportioned by formula to the library systems on the basis of population and geography (http://www.georgialibraries.org/lib/library_laws/OCGA - 20-5-3.pdf).
- State funding is provided for professional salaries, library materials, operational support, libraries for the blind and physically handicapped, and, by grant award, for capital improvement.
- Georgia is the only state that provides grants that are specifically designated for the salaries of professional librarians, thus ensuring that each system is administered and led by licensed librarians.
- In FY2014, Georgia ranked 13th in the nation in terms of state funding per capita for public libraries, at \$2.60 while the national average was \$2.70.
- Even with the significant funding provided by the state, in FY2014 Georgia ranked 47th in the nation in terms of **total** per capita funding of public libraries at \$19.46. The national average for **total** per capita funding was \$38.11. Note: FY2014 is the most recent year for which IMLS has published national data tables.
- In FY2016, Georgia's per capita state funding was \$2.75.



Local Funding for Georgia's Public Libraries

- Local funding (including one-time funding but not capital funding) for Georgia's public libraries varied widely across the state in FY2016, from \$4.76 to \$29.31. In FY2015, local funding ranged from \$5.02 to \$29.54 per capita.
- The majority of the public library systems in Georgia (over 79%) received local funding that was below the statewide average of \$15.95.
- For FY2016, local funding for **all** 63 of Georgia's library systems was below the FY2014 national average of \$32.44.
- Georgia ranked 47th in the nation in local funding per capita for public libraries in FY2014.
- Three public library systems (De Soto Trail Regional Library, Ohoopee Regional Library, and Ocmulgee Regional Library System) received more state funding than local funding.
- When looking at the amount of funding provided to all Georgia libraries by state and local sources, 15% came from the state while 85% came from local sources.


Local Funding Per Capita FY 2016

- Total grant funding between FY 2005 and FY 2017 has been approximately \$105 million
- Total local match funding between FY2005 and FY 2017 has been approximately \$140 million
- Total project costs have been over \$220 million



Library Cards and Circulation

- In FY2016, 3,948,476 individuals in Georgia held public library cards, a 10% decrease over FY 2015. This decrease is the result of the PINES automation and lending network implementing routine database “housekeeping” in order to delete inactive library cards. The latest Georgia QuickFacts from the U.S. Census reported a total of 3,574,362 Georgia households, resulting in an average of 1.1 registered public library patrons per Georgia household.
- 38% of all Georgians are registered public library patrons.
- Library systems that participate in Georgia Public Library Service's PINES automation and lending network counted 1,860,321 active PINES library cards as of June 30, 2016. This is a reduction of 24% from June 30, 2015, due to the deletion of inactive library cards, as mentioned above.
- More than half of all registered public library patrons in Georgia live in a county that is part of a library system that participates in PINES.
- Georgia libraries circulated over 38 million library items or 3.68 items per capita in FY2016, which is an increase over FY2015. Of note, E-book circulation increased over 20%.
- Georgia ranked 48th among states in circulation per capita in FY2014.

Percentage of Library System Population with Library Cards - FY 2016



Resource Sharing – Interlibrary Loans and Courier Service

- Public libraries provide lending services to their card holders. Each time a user checks out an item, it is considered a circulation. Another type of circulation, which requires at least three times the workload of a circulation, is Interlibrary Loan. This is a service where a user of one library can borrow books that are owned by another library. The user makes a request with their local library, which identifies libraries that own the desired item, places the request, receives the item, makes it available to the user, and arranges for its return.
- Georgia Online Database (GOLD) – GPLS coordinates the interlibrary loaning of books and other materials between libraries of all types including academic, public, technical schools and special libraries. Over 200 institutions loaned and borrowed almost 39,000 items between each other in FY2015.
- GPLS contracts for library **courier service**, which transported **1,441,717** library materials in FY2016, visiting every headquarters library five (5) days per week. This includes Interlibrary Loan items as well as PINES system-to-system items being transported across the state.
- Both Interlibrary Loan and PINES system-to-system loans require the librarian to receive the request, pull the book from the shelves, check it out of the online library catalog, and prepare a mailing package or a PINES courier package to send the item to the requesting library. This work is overlooked when using only circulation as a statistic for workload of the library staff, but it accounted for 655,820 items sent to other library systems for patron use. Of these loans, 628,221 were processed through the Georgia Library PINES network.



Public Access Computers in Georgia Public Libraries

- Public Library Internet computers were used almost 12 million times in FY2016.
- There were 9,353 public computer workstations with high-speed internet access in Georgia public libraries at the close of FY2016.
- Coordinated by GPLS in Georgia, the federal E-rate program -- the national Universal Service Discount Program for Schools and Libraries -- provides over 75% of the funds for Georgia's statewide public library data network.
- All public access internet computers have access to GALILEO databases.
- GALILEO databases searches numbered almost 1.5 million through public library access in FY2016, an increase of 15% over FY2015.
- 94% of Georgia library facilities provide wireless services for library users.
- The following Charts and Spreadsheets on “Public Access Computers” use do not include use from patrons’ wireless devices.

Public Library Service Hours

- In FY2016, public library service hours in Georgia increased 3.4% over FY2015; this is the second year in a row with an increase in hours. From FY2009-2014, due to reduced local and state funding in the last five years, hours steadily decreased. Despite the increase, FY2016 hours are still over 7% lower than in FY2009.
- 19 of the 63 public library systems now show increased hours over FY2009. Of those, four systems (Bartram Trail, Forsyth County, Newton County, and Uncle Remus) have increased their public service hours by more than 30%. An additional six systems (Coweta County, DeKalb County, Lee County, South Georgia Regional, Southwest Georgia Regional, and West Georgia Regional) all increased hours more than 10%.
- 40 systems have been forced to reduce public service hours since FY2009, with 14 of them reducing hours more than 20%.


Collections Owned by Georgia Public Libraries

- At the end of FY2016, there were 19,582,069 (1.89 per capita) print, electronic, audio, and video items in the collections of Georgia public libraries.
- 56% of Georgia public library systems were above the state average of 1.89 items per capita.
- As the population of Georgia has grown, the state's ranking in print materials per capita has remained near the bottom; Georgia ranked 46th in the nation in this category in FY2014, which is an improvement over the 49th place ranking in FY2012.
- Of note for FY2016, with over 700,000 e-books available to the public, Georgia libraries offered over 75% more e-books than in FY2015.

Per Capita Expenditures for Books and Other Library Materials

- Georgia public libraries spent an average of \$1.65 per capita for materials in FY2016.
- The per capita expenditure for materials in Georgia public libraries has historically been below the national average, which in FY2014 was \$4.03 per capita; Georgia ranked 49th that year with an expenditure per capita of \$1.50. In FY2016, all Georgia public libraries are below this national average.
- The majority of Georgia public library systems (over 75%) fell below the state average of \$1.65 per capita for FY2016.



Materials Expenditures Per Capita FY 2016




Expenditures of Georgia's Public Libraries

Per Capita Expenditures for Staff in Georgia Public Libraries

- Georgia public libraries spent an average of \$13.21 per capita for staff in FY2016, an increase of 5% over the FY2015 average of 12.64.
- All 63 library systems in Georgia spent less than the FY14 national average per capita of \$23.97 for staff.
- The majority (45) of Georgia public library systems spent less than the state average per capita of \$13.21 for staff.

Total Public Library Expenditures


- Georgia public libraries spent an average of \$18.90 per capita on operating expenditures in FY2016, a 5% increase over the FY15 operating expenditure of \$18.05.
- 35% of Georgia's public library systems spent more per capita than the state average of \$18.90 in FY2016.
- On a per capita basis, all public library systems spent less in FY2016 than the FY2014 national average of \$35.80.
- Georgia ranked 48th in the United States for public library total operating expenditures per capita in FY2014.

Key Services of GPLS for Georgia's Public Libraries

- Represent and advocate for public libraries at the state and national levels
- Administer state and federal grants
- Administer the capital construction and MRR grant programs
- Provide consulting services through phone and email correspondence and on-site visits
- Provide training for library staff and trustees
- Promote and facilitate resource sharing and strategic partnerships
- Coordinate statewide programs that promote family literacy for children and parents
- Coordinate statewide library statistics
- Provide funding, support, and management of broadband networks statewide
- Provide centralized support and hosting for cloud computing for public access computers
- Provide web-hosting and email hosting
- Administer and support PINES -- The **P**ublic **I**nformation **N**etwork for **E**lectronic **S**ervices, the Georgia public library automation and lending network
- Provide Help Desk support for PINES and technology needs, available via online access and toll-free phone number
- Provide access to GALILEO, both on-site at all libraries and at home for validated patrons
- Administer GLASS, which provides library services and accessible technology for readers whose physical abilities require the use of books and magazines in audio or braille formats
- Provide a professional materials collection for practicing librarians and for library school students

Expenditures and Staffing of GPLS - FY 2016

- In Fiscal Year 2016, total state funding for Georgia Public Library Service was approximately \$32.9 million, 79.8% of which was distributed directly to public libraries under the grants program.
- Georgia Public Library Service used 8.9% of its budget for agency operations while 11.3% was spent on on-behalf services to libraries, including the costs of coordinating the statewide public library initiatives of PINES, GALILEO and internet services.
- A total of **51** positions are allocated for the Georgia Public Library Service. Only **46.5** of these are currently filled.
 - GLASS – 17 FTE
 - PINES and IT – 14 FTE
 - Library Development – 4.5 FTE
 - Administration and Business Services – 11 FTE

GPLS – FY2016 Benchmarks and Milestones

PINES

- Continued to facilitate resource sharing, with intraPINES loans of 628,221
- Circulated 17,264,835 items as of FY16
- Over 1.8 million PINES library cards in use during FY16
- Extended and continued to maintain the PINES integrated library computer system in 53 public library systems and served patrons in all 159 Georgia counties
- Contracted with a courier (book delivery) service among all public library system central facilities and University System of Georgia (USG) academic libraries, making the collections of these libraries truly a statewide resource
- Participated in the wider Evergreen community by continuing cooperative software development efforts
- Provided quarterly scheduled training and customized on-demand sessions for the PINES member library systems

General Public Library Support

- Continued to work with libraries and local funding agencies to maintain excellence in services through challenging economic times
- Provided continuing support to Friends of Georgia Libraries
- Continued to provide training for library staff and trustees through both instructor-led training on demand and through scholarships to training offered by outside vendors
- Provided local strategic planning assistance to public library systems

- Continued to administer and utilize funds provided by the federal Library Services and Technology Act toward the improvement and enhancement of library services in Georgia
- Continued to coordinate, gather, and publish public library statistics for information, decision-making, and advocacy

Planning and Construction

- Consulted with public library stakeholders in the development and implementation of public library design standards
- Continued to work with the Georgia State Financing and Investment Commission in funding for construction and with public libraries in implementation of capital outlay programs
- Coordinated Georgia's public library planning and construction program, a match program assisting in new library construction as well as renovations and additions
- Completed over 65 state-funded projects since 2005 with an additional 28 projects in the planning process awaiting awards
- Total grant funding between FY05 and FY17 has been approximately \$105 million

Youth Services

- In FY2016, helped public libraries strengthen local partnerships with agencies, institutions, businesses, and groups by coordinating LSTA-funded PRIME TIME Family Reading Time® programs at eight sites in seven library systems (Chattahoochee Valley Libraries, Coastal Plain Regional Library, DeKalb County Public Library, Marshes of Glynn Libraries, Roddenberry Memorial Library, Statesboro Regional Library, Three Rivers Regional Library System)
- 1,966 children and caregivers attended these PRIME TIME programs in FY16
- In FY16, Georgia's statewide Summer Reading Program enjoyed children's program attendance of 509,990
- GPLS coordinated a National Leadership Grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services for B4: Birth to 4, Georgia's Early Literacy Initiative
- Partnered with other agencies, such as Georgia Department of Education, Georgia Humanities, Voices for Georgia's Children, Bright From the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning, Get Georgia Reading: Campaign for Grade Level Reading, and the Path2College 529 College Savings Plan, to help strengthen Georgia libraries' youth services programs

Services for the Blind and Others Requiring Books and Magazines in Audio Formats or in Braille

- Provided library services for the blind and others whose physical abilities require the use of books and magazines in audio format or in braille through Georgia Libraries for Accessible Statewide Services (GLASS), a network of libraries and a central distribution center

- GLASS provided materials to 15,521 registered users across Georgia in FY16
- GLASS circulated (mailed) 328,613 items to eligible enrolled readers in Georgia
- GLASS provided access to digital titles that were downloaded 119,561 times in FY16
- Promoted emphasis on outreach and patron services at the local level
- Hosted the 2016 Georgia Accessibility Conference where librarians from public libraries across the state learned about ways to provide library services to people with special needs
- Continued to assist readers with the transition from audio cassette to a digital book and magazine collection
- Recorded books by Georgia authors to be added to the BARD digital download catalog
- Developed a partnership with PINES libraries to enhance service delivery for GLASS patrons
- Developed a partnership with Benetech to provide access to Bookshare, a digital collection of 500,000 titles in accessible formats

Strategic Partnerships

- Georgia Public Library Service partners with a number of state and private organizations to provide an additional layer of support and build awareness for the state's public libraries. These partnership programs have educated and entertained thousands of Georgia residents while saving more than \$13 million in direct expenditures and providing hundreds of hours of free programming for public libraries.
- During FY2016, GPLS added the Georgia National Fair and the GFB Foundation for Agriculture, along with seven Georgia units of the National Park Service, to its roster of community partners. Strategic partnership programs were

renewed this year with Georgia State Parks & Historic Sites, the Atlanta Braves, the Atlanta Hawks, Zoo Atlanta, the Center for Puppetry Arts, the Go Fish Education Center, and VSA Arts of Georgia.

Communications

- Average distribution of the bimonthly GPLS News rose nearly 3 percent to 4,578, including copies provided to libraries, staff and trade show attendees. Hard-copy subscriptions rose to 2,621, and electronic subscriptions grew to 396, with a 1 percent increase (up to 43 percent) in “open rate,” which tracks the percentage of people who actually open the newsletter and read it. According to MailChimp tracking statistics, this is more than double the average for government agencies (21 percent) in the US.
- GPLS also saw social media interest in public libraries increase dramatically during the year, with Facebook followers increasing by 31 percent to 1,955—with the statistical average reach of our posts more than doubling. FY2016 was the first year of compiling full tracking info for the GPLS Twitter account, with 1,380 followers and 226 average impressions per day.

Technology-based Support

- Provided a centralized resource for broadband network management and E-Rate application support, assisting the libraries with vendor management, contract negotiation, and fiscal and billing reconciliation
- Provided maintenance and support for servers hosting centralized email and SPAM filtering for 47 library systems

- Provided technical support, maintenance, and hosting of websites for over 35 library systems
- Circulated 5 Technology Loaner Kits, consisting of over 25 pieces of hardware, allowing staff and patron access to emerging and innovative technologies, including virtual reality and 3D printing. Designed and developed 6 new kits slated to enter rotation early 2017; kits include 3 new street-view kits, 2 high-end VR kits, and an additional 3D printing kit
- In the form of workshops, presentations and individual talks, provided outreach featuring technology-related services and programming in order to raise awareness of technology trends and adoptions in public libraries
- Hosted a Technology Boot Camp, an initiative of GPLS to bring together IT professionals from Georgia public libraries—and in FY16 included library staff from nearby states as well. Sharing experiences and ideas and exploring opportunities made possible by emerging technologies resulted in a clearinghouse of current IT trends and practices, which is updated and maintained year-round: <http://galibtech.org/>
- Provision of a help desk for library technology – closed over 442 IT inquiries between 9/10/15 and 6/30/16 (reporting not available prior to 9/10/15 due to migration to a new help desk system)
- Hosted and supported over 1,300 cloud-based public access computers for the majority of Georgia public libraries; migrated GPLS, GDC, and GLASS Atlanta to cloud-based email

Continuing Education and Training

- Produced Virtual Staff Day, an online learning experience, for over 1,000 attendees
- In FY16, GPLS hosted live continuing education and training events for library staff, reaching 4,569 staff members. In addition, 2,351 users accessed training through the online portals of Lynda.com and Skillport, for a total figure of 6,920
- Administered Georgia Library Education Network (GLEAN) access for over 2,500 public, school and academic library employees
- Provided 5,000+ on-demand e-learning courses through GLEAN to a diverse audience of eligible library employees
- Collaborated with other state library agencies to provide Georgia libraries with monthly, comprehensive listings of free webinars covering a range of industry-related competencies and subject areas
- Promoted flexible training and continuing education programs in individual library systems by providing public libraries free access to WebEx Enterprise Edition

Resource Sharing

- Administered the reciprocal borrowing and lending activity of more than 200 GOLD multitype member libraries resulting in lending 142,982 items and borrowing 119,430 through interlibrary loans during FY16
- Purchased group access to OCLC Services for all public libraries, including a group catalog, that allows patrons access to resources beyond their library's holdings
- Paid GALILEO resource fees for all 63 public library systems to provide patron access to the statewide virtual library
- Expanded GALILEO resources for public libraries to include online language learning
- Purchased group access to the RDA Toolkit for all public libraries
- Continued to support Georgia HomePLACE as a component of the Digital Library of Georgia

Georgia Public Library Service (GPLS) – History

- A state library agency has existed in Georgia since the late 19th century.
- From 1943-1996, the agency was a unit of the Georgia Department of Education.
- From 1996-2000, the agency was a unit of the Georgia Department of Technical and Adult Education, now Technical College System of Georgia.
- Since 2000, GPLS has been a unit of the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia.
